

A Missouri Bank Defalcation.

RICHMOND, Mo., Jan. 19.—Bank Examiner Clark has finished his investigation of the Ray County Bank's affairs, to discover the amount of the alleged shortage of John W. Shotwell, Jr., the missing cashier, and has given the exact figures at \$17,286. It is now stated that the Ray County funds held by the bank are short \$7,172, making a total alleged defalcation of \$24,428.
